EOSSAA Transfer Update

June 13, 2014

Any student who transfers from one school to another is ineligible to play sports for their new school until they have been deemed eligible by the local association. Any student who is declared ineligible may appeal to EOSSAA but they must first be ruled on by the local committee. If they are ruled ineligible at EOSSAA, they may continue their appeal to OFSAA. Local associations should plan to have their own transfer meeting approximately one week prior to the EOSSAA meetings to allow for ample time to formulate an appeal.

It is the responsibility of the Athletic Director, the School Principal, the individual transfer representative and/or the guidance department at each school to familiarize themselves with the rules and regulations regarding new transfer students to your school.

Transfer issues continue to be dealt with at the local level and the process is improving with each passing year. One of the major concerns are the deadlines that need to be followed, local associations need to be aware of the EOSSAA and OFSAA deadlines and they need to have their meetings scheduled to accommodate these dates. **The EOSSAA committee will only meet if there are appeal cases that are brought forward (faxed or emailed)**<u>at least two days</u> before the scheduled meeting date.
