

EOSSAA
Co-Educational Golf
Playing Regulations

1. Date:

The EOSSAA golf championship shall be held at least 10 days prior to the first day of the respective OFSAA festival/championship. ie. the boys and girls championships may be held on different dates.

2. Location:

The location of the EOSSAA golf championship shall be decided at the June AGM prior to the championship.

3. Events:

There shall be both a boys and girls EOSSAA golf championship each year. Both events shall be 18 holes and be conducted on the same day, at the same course until numbers prove impractical

Both boys and girls shall play a team division and an individual division

Each local Association shall be permitted to enter two(2) teams and the next two(2) low individuals **not on the winning teams(2)** in each of the boys and girls events

The local association teams shall consist of four players with the top three(3) scores being added, lowest total winning, thereby advancing to EOSSAA

4. OFSAA qualification:

Boys: Each Association shall be allowed one team of four(4) golfers, and the next two(2) low individuals **not on the winning team** advancing to OFSAA thereby representing EOSSAA(**six golfers per association**)

Girls:

Day One - Individual event, top six(6) per association (being from six different schools is permissible):

*four(4) golfers count, fifth is used in a tie breaker, then sixth

*an individual and Association champion will be determined from the combined score of the six Association representatives

Day Two - Team Event

School teams of four(4), top three(3) scores count;

Two teams per Association

At the conclusion of the EOSSAA championship the OFSAA qualifiers shall receive information and/or an information package from the EOSSAA convenor detailing entry procedures for the OFSAA championship

5. Entries

Entries to EOSSAA shall be accepted from local Association convenors or designates only
Entries must be received by the convenor five(5) days before the date of the EOSSAA championship

Any suspension or disciplinary actions in local Association play shall be carried forward to the EOSSAA championship

6. Expenses:

An entry fee shall be charged to cover the operating costs of the event.

Each local association representative to the EOSSAA championship must pay the fee determined by the convenor before being permitted to play in the EOSSAA championship

7. Eligibility: To represent a school in any EOSSAA activity a student must:

*be eligible for competition under the Constitution, By-Laws and Standing Rules(Playing Regulations) of the Association to which his/her school belongs

*Comply with the age requirement in the OFSAA Constitution

*be in grades 9-12

*be eligible under the OFSAA Transfer Policy

*be eligible for no more than five(5) consecutive years from date of entry into Grade 9

*have signed the Rules of Behaviour form for the competition

*Be a full time student

*be certified eligible by the Principal of the school

8. Tournament Structure:

- *a coaches' meeting shall be held prior to the start of the EOSSAA championship
- *information arising from the coaches' meeting shall be conveyed to a gathering of players prior to the start of the EOSSAA championship
- *play shall be in foursomes as numbers permit
- *where possible players from the same school shall not be together in a foursome
- *coaching will not be permitted on the course
- *caddies will not be permitted for participants
- *local association convenors should provide rankings for individuals
- *Spectators(parents) are not allowed on the course
- *players shall keep the score of playing partners
- *officials designated by the convenor shall be available to resolve issues that arise on the course
- *where possible a pin position sheet should be provided for all participants

10. Supervision Responsibilities:

- *Coaches must remain on site and be available for a duty during the tournament
- *The convenor shall assign supervision duties for coaches on the day of the event

11. Rules and Officials:

The laws of the current version of the RCGA Rules and host course adaptations of the RCGA Rules shall govern play at the EOSSAA championship

The convenor must designate or act as the head official for the EOSSAA championship

12. Tie Breakers:

*In individual competition the RCGA retrogression rule will apply

*In team competition the number one(low) score shall be used to break a tie. If a tie still exists the number two(second lowest), score shall be used to break, followed by successive scores.

13 Uniforms/Attire:

All competitors are expected to match, if not exceed, the dress code of the host course

It is the coach's responsibility to ensure the dress code of the host course is followed

14. Awards:

The winner of the individual event shall receive an EOSSAA gold medal

The members of the winning team shall receive EOSSAA gold medals and an EOSSAA plaque

15. Deportment:

All participants are expected to abide by the "Rules of Behaviour for Participants at an EOSSAA championship"

All competitors are expected to demonstrate respect and compliance for the rules of golf

16. Jury of Appeal:

The Jury of Appeal shall consist of three individuals: the convenor and two(2) other individuals appointed by the convenor. The Jury of Appeal shall handle disputes which fall within the realm of:

Rules and Officials

Uniforms/Attire

Scoring

A dispute must be submitted in writing to the convenor or designate together with a \$50 fee prior to the signing of the score card at the conclusion of the game(refundable if upheld) within thirty(30) minutes, except as provided within specific sport governing regulations, of the conclusion of the game in which the incident occurred.

Decisions of the Jury of appeal shall be final.
